Letter from the Pastor

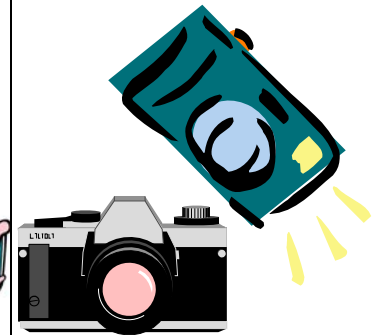


Photo Club
