Proverbs 3:1-10

Instruction:

My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart,

Blessing:

For they will prolong your life many years and bring you peace and prosperity.

Instruction:

Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.

Blessing:

Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man.

Instruction:

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him.

Blessing:

He will make your paths straight.

Instruction:

Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil.

Blessing:

This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

Instruction:

Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the first fruits of all your crops.

Blessing:

Then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

There are times we don't want others caught up in our business. We want to do what we want to do, when we want to do it and how we want it done. We don't always want someone giving us their opinion.

But when it comes to scripture, God gives us the instruction but also shows us the benefits as we follow His word. When we are obedient to God's word, this sets the foundation for us to receive His blessings. When we fail in following His commands, we suffer the consequences.
