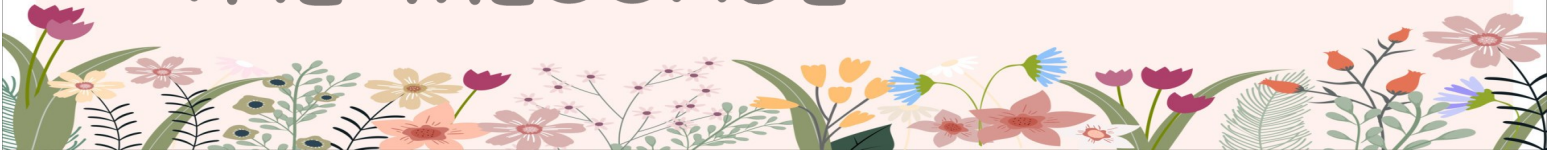


THE MESSAGE

April - FBC of Los Osos



Here is a portion of my daily devotion, "Good morning, Church," I sent out earlier this week.

Psalm 122:1 "I was glad when they said to me,
"Let us go to the house of the LORD!" (ESV)

Yesterday, I went with a husband of 62 years to visit his wife at a local care facility. She was recently diagnosed with congestive heart failure and not given long to live. When we arrived, she was visiting with her daughter and the hospice nurse. After the nurse left, I was able to move up closer to her and have a chance to talk and read some scripture to her and pray for her.

For all the health issues she is facing, she still has a joyful spirit. We talked for a few minutes, and one thing she mentioned was how much she missed going to church. After attending church for nearly 82 years, playing the piano and helping in worship, that part of her life has been taken from her. But, her joy in the Lord has not been lost.

I enjoy the Phil Wickham song , "House of the Lord." Here is the beginning part. (Check out the whole song.)

Psalm 100:4-5 "Enter his gates with thanksgiving
and his courts with praise;
give thanks to him and praise his name.
For the Lord is good and his love endures forever;
his faithfulness continues through all generations." (NIV)
