June - FBC of Los Osos

I am excited to share, when asked, where we are in the merger process. When asked, I remind people what we have been doing for the past several months and what will happen next. So far, we have had several prayer meetings and Q&A sessions hosted by both churches. Pastor Jeremy has come to speak at our church twice. We introduced Jeremy's family: wife, Kristin and two children, Sarah and Hudson. We have held a leadership meeting, inviting all church leaders to come and got briefed on where things were in the process and gave them a chance to ask questions. We have shared a new vision and mission statement for our church as we merge our churches together.

Then, I share what is next. For the month of June, I will meet with the church council on the 11th to come up with a proposal for the church to vote on. This proposal will either be to continue with the merge or to say no to the merge. Either way, the church will need to make some decisions to know where we go from there. I see this as a great opportunity for our one new church to have a greater impact on serving our local families and reaching the lost on the Central Coast, as well as, for me to have the opportunity to share in ministry once again with Pastor Jeremy.

After knowing what will be proposed, I will put out an update to the church as we have set June 30th as a date for our church to vote on the presented proposal. On June 23rd, I will stay after church to answer any questions for anyone who wishes to stay and/or pray about the vote. This will be an informal meeting and no vote will be taken on any matter.

Also, on June 30th, North Morro Church will have their special called business meeting for their church to vote on the merge. Again, both churches must vote yes for the merge to go forth. If both churches vote to merge, then on July 28th, we will have our first combined service with a BBQ to celebrate our churches coming together.

Two other items will be up for our church to consider and vote on at the June 30th meeting. First, since Heather Copple resigned as our volunteer youth director, our Children's director, Kim Pruitt, has been filling in. We will present to the council and ask for Kim to now be the Family Ministry Director. Kim will work with her team of volunteers to help staff all classes, plus help coordinate activities for all children and youth.

Next, we are looking to fill the music director's position. Melissa and Bill Vedrin have been super faithful in helping to lead and coordinate our Sunday morning worship team for the past four years. But now, we would like to consider our music program with a new vision and direction if the merge does happen. Kaitlyn Lewis sang with our team on May 24th and has a beautiful voice and a music degree. She also has led worship in the past, teaches music and voice, and plays three instruments. We will share more about Kaitlyn as time goes on. She will be leading worship for us on June 16th. Kaitlyn is a member and volunteer at NMC.

I have spoken to many inside our church and within our denomination who have shared many encouraging comments about the possibility of this merge and the real positive outcome this could have on both of our churches. Now, it will be up to the churches to see if this is God's will for both of our churches. "Therefore, if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort provided by love, any fellowship in the Spirit, any affection or mercy, complete my joy and be of the same mind, by having the same love, being united in spirit, and having one purpose." (Philippians 2:1-2 NET)

return home from camp. I will be sending out a camp pack list and other information during the first week in June. Please reach out if you have any questions at this time.



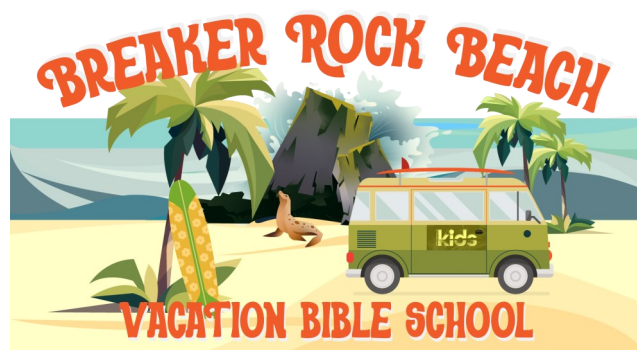
Vacation Bible School Meetings

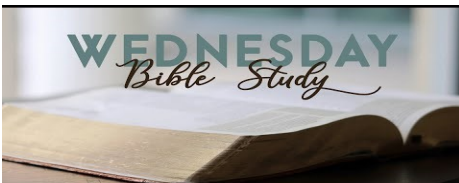
